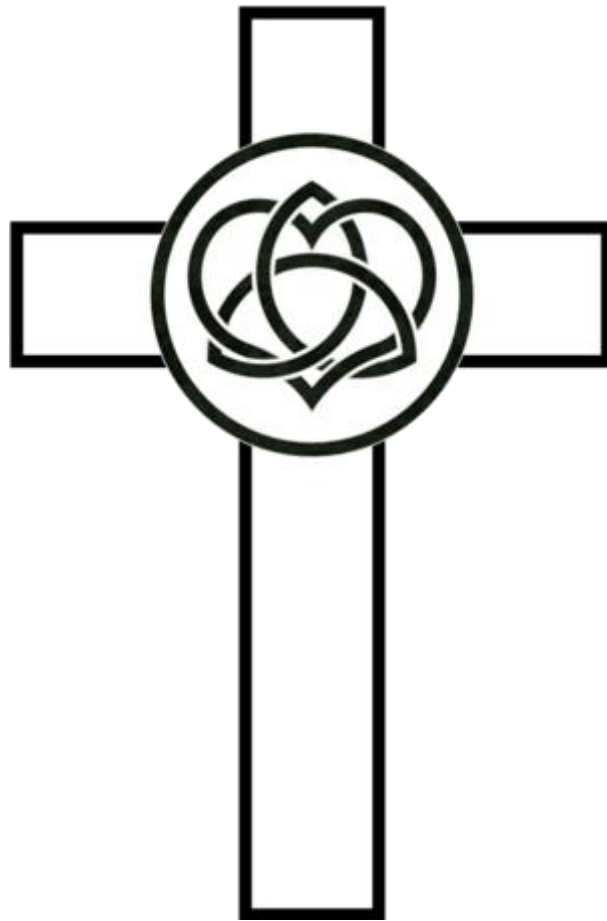


# *Grace Reformed*

We are a church that loves the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, and through that gospel, by repentance and faith in Christ, are seeking to grow in love for our Triune God, his church, and our neighbors.

**Welcome!** We are pleased to have you with us this morning as we worship our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! We believe worship is about gathering together to meet with the Triune God. During worship we believe that God:

- **Draws** near to expose our sins so that we can repent of them
- **Forgives** our sins so that we can be reconciled to him and each other
- **Pours** his love into our hearts
- **Comforts** the mourning
- **Strengthens** the weak
- **Heals** the broken
- **Encourages** the sorrowful
- **Deepens** our faith
- **Refreshes and Renews** our love and obedience to his Word.

Our worship follows a dialogue format, where God speaks to us through his Bible and reflections on his Word, and we respond to him in different ways like listening, singing, praying, repenting, confessing, etc. In this “holy conversation” Jesus tells us about himself, and about us, and about how we can grow closer to him and look more like him in our daily lives. *Therefore, so that we can focus on what God is doing and saying, we ask that you if you are not using your cellphone to read the Bible and access the liturgy to please turn off or silence them during the worship service; or if you are using them to limit yourself to those activities (airplane mode is helpful with this).* Also, meeting with God is not just for adults! Jesus welcomes all of us, including little children. If you have children, we are delighted to have them worship with us in the worship service! We encourage you to help them worship and quietly answer questions they may have during worship. If you are new to church and don't know the answers, or want help in how to encourage their participation, you are very much invited to speak with our pastor or one of the elders. We very much want you and your children to be able to understand and participate in worship as much as possible. To help you follow along more easily, please note that ***bold italicized text*** are words that we say out loud together. #### **Meditation Verse and Prelude: John 14:8-11**

[During the prelude ask the Triune God to help you worship him through repentance and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.] Philip said to him, “Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us.” Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, ‘Show us the Father’? Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, but the Father who dwells in me does his works. Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or else believe on account of the works themselves.

#### **God’s Call to Confession: Exodus 20:17**

You shall not covet your neighbor’s house; you shall not covet your neighbor’s wife, or his male servant, or his female servant, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything that is your neighbor’s.

### **Our Corporate Confession of Sin:**

[After this, a time of silent, personal confession follows, where we can confess our individual sins individually]

***O Lord, forgive us our failure to keep your commandments. We confess that we cleanse the outside of our lives enough to pretend to be righteous but neglect the deep repentance you call us to. We confess that we love our opinions and thoughts more than your word. We love our idols more than your worship. We love our free time more than our neighbors. Our hearts and lives are open before you, the Righteous Judge, who sees and knows all things. And we know that before your justice we stand condemned. But you are not only our judge. You are our Savior. Father, forgive us for these sins through the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ, who lived and died to pay the penalty for our evil. And through his blood, by the power of the Holy Spirit, work in us deep repentance that loves your word, your worship, and our neighbors as you have called us to, so that we might bear witness to this world of your transforming grace and offer up our lives as a sacrifice of praise for your mercy. Amen.***

### **God's Assurance of Pardon: Romans 5:1-2**

Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

### **Our Corporate Response of Praise: Psalm 65:3-4**

***When iniquities prevail against me, you atone for our transgressions. Blessed is the one you choose and bring near, to dwell in your courts. We shall be satisfied with the goodness of your house, the holiness of your temple!***

#### \*Our Confession of Faith: Heidelberg Catechism Q&A 92

Q. What is God's law?

**A. God spoke all these words:**

THE FIRST COMMANDMENT - ***"I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery; you shall have no other gods before me."***

THE SECOND COMMANDMENT - ***"You shall not make for yourself an idol, whether in form of anything that is in heaven above, or that is on the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, punishing children for the iniquity of parents, to the third and the fourth generation of those who reject me, but showing love to the thousandth generation of those who love me and keep my commandments."***

THE THIRD COMMANDMENT - ***"You shall not make wrongful use of the name of the LORD your God, for the LORD will not acquit anyone who misuses his name."***

THE FOURTH COMMANDMENT - ***"Remember the sabbath day and keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work. But the seventh day is a sabbath to the LORD your God; you shall not do any work—you, your son or your daughter, your male or female slave, your livestock, or the alien resident in your towns. For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but rested the seventh day; therefore, the LORD blessed the sabbath day and consecrated it."***

THE FIFTH COMMANDMENT - ***"Honor your father and your mother, so that your days may be long in the land that the LORD your God is giving to you."***

THE SIXTH COMMANDMENT - ***“You shall not murder.”***

THE SEVENTH COMMANDMENT - ***“You shall not commit adultery.”***

THE EIGHTH COMMANDMENT - ***“You shall not steal.”***

THE NINTH COMMANDMENT - ***“You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.”***

THE TENTH COMMANDMENT - ***“You shall not covet your neighbor’s house; you shall not covet your neighbor’s wife, or male or female slave, or ox, or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.”***
